97% of the Earth's water is stored in it's oceans. The average depth of the ocean is **3700m**. The total volume of water in the ocean is **1.35** billion km³. That's enough water to fill about

352,670,000,000,000,000 gallon-sized

milk containers! **70**% of the oxygen we breathe comes from marine plants. The ocean, with around **38,000** gigatonnes of carbon, contains **16 times** as much carbon as all plant and underlying soils on our planet. On average, seawater in the world's oceans has a salinity of approximately **3.5**%, or **35 parts per thousand**. This means that for every **1 litre** of seawater there are **35 grams** of salts dissolved in it.
